WHISTLEBLOWER PROTECTION

A “whistleblower” discloses information they reasonably believe evidences:

- A violation of any law, rule, or regulation
- Gross mismanagement
- A gross waste of funds
- An abuse of authority
- A substantial and specific danger to public health or public safety

The Office of the Inspector General provides a confidential channel for DIA employees to make confidential disclosures. We evaluate the disclosure to determine whether there is a substantial likelihood that one of the listed categories have been disclosed. If such a determination is made, we will investigate the matter.
